

Biography of Thomas G. Green



Thomas G. Green, MBA, CIA, has more than 23 years of experience in Risk Advisory Services, internal audit, ERM implementation and fraud investigations. He also has significant SOX experience, and a deep knowledge of COSO, the International Professional Practices Framework, and the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act (FCPA).

Mr. Green graduated from Brigham Young University with a degree in Political Science. He graduated with an MBA from Louisiana State University's E.J. Ourso College of Business and from the school's Center for Internal Auditing (Center). The Center is widely recognized as the world's foremost internal auditing program associated with a university.

Based on his experience at LSU, in 2008, Mr. Green began assisting Utah Valley University (UVU) in creating a similar internal audit program. This program has become a required component for all accounting students at UVU. The program also assists students in obtaining internships and full-time employment in internal audit in the state of Utah and other states. Mr. Green is a frequent adjunct professor and guest lecturer at

a number of universities along the Wasatch Front, and frequently addresses public, private and governmental internal audit groups and organizations. He recently presented a three-day seminar on risks and controls to the Utah State Board of Education.

Mr. Green has internal audit experience working for two global CPA firms, a global not-for-profit organization, a Fortune 100 company, a global professional services firm and as the chief internal auditor for a Utah-based public company. For the past seven years he has been Piercy Bowler Taylor and Kern's (PBTk) Principal in charge of their internal audit practice. PBTk is a regional CPA firm with offices in Salt Lake City, Utah and Las Vegas and Reno, Nevada. Between the three offices they have about 100 personnel.

He has performed Risk Advisory Services projects and fraud investigations in about 40 countries, territories or states, including Canada, Mexico, Australia, Colombia, Bermuda, China, Japan, the Philippines, Russia, Ecuador, England, Scotland, Belgium, Germany, Guam, France, and Ireland.

From 2003 to the present, Mr. Green has volunteered with the Salt Lake Chapter of the Institute of Internal Auditor, serving twice as chapter president. He is currently a member the Academic Relations Committee. An Orem native, he currently resides in Provo with his wife and daughter, who is a senior at Timpview High School.
